Earlier in August, all district parents received a letter with instructions on how to complete our yearly paperwork to start our school year. The instructions included an access code that is unique to their student. After linking students to the parent accounts, this portal will eliminate the piles and piles of paper we traditional send home at the start of every school year. In addition, this portal will become the first stop on staying up to date on all the events and information for our school district. The parent portal is synced with our school's website, activity calendar, and Progressbook, our district's new on-line gradebook feature. Now parents, with a single login, can check in on their student's grades, news, as well as, update phone numbers, addresses, and other contact information. To assist our parents in transitioning to this platform, we will have staff on hand during our Student Orientation Night. Located in the Elementary Computer Lab, staff will be able to help parents create accounts, link students, and fill out the information.

Families that are new to our district will follow a similar on-line process to register new students to our district. This will result in a more efficient and accurate process in welcoming new students to our school.

In case you haven't heard, our preschool is also expanding. In previous years, we've only been able to work with 46 preschoolers. This year our enrollment is pushing 70! This is very exciting as we provide a strong educational foundation for our youngest learners.

Although these are only two of the programs or improvement that that we are developing for the start of the new year, they do represent our district's dedication to improving the educational experience for your student.
