

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS ABOUT THE HIGH SCHOOL SUMMER LEARNING PROGRAMS

1. Can anyone attend the high school summer learning program?

Priority is given to currently enrolled New London Local Schools' students. Students who live in the New London Local School District attendance area, but attend a parochial or charter school can attend if space is available. Students who live outside of the district may enroll if space is available. Non-NL students will be charged a \$10.00 registration fee.

2. Is there a charge to attend the high school summer learning program?

Yes. All registered students pay \$150.00 per full credit course and P.E. Half credit courses are \$100.00.

3. Where do I turn in my registration form and payment for the summer program?

Registration for non-NL students begin June 5, 2017 either at the New London High School Guidance Office or the New London Board of Education Offices. Payment must be provided at time of registration. There will be a \$10.00 registration fee applied to all Non-NLHS students.

4. My child attends a parochial and/or charter school. Can my child attend the High School summer learning programs

Non-NLLS students will be accepted. All high school students will be accepted if space allows. Please refer to the Registration Information on the previous page.

5. Can middle school students attend High School Summer school?

No. At this time, only high school students are accepted into this program.
