## **High School Summer School Programs Information**

**High School Summer School:** The district will offer online summer school classes from June 12 - July 29, 2019. All course work will be offered through Odysseyware, an online platform that allows students to access their coursework 24 hours per day, 7 days a week. Students will provide their own device and internet connectivity. In addition, coursework is to be completed outside of the school campus.

**Attendance** Daily attendance is not required for this program, as the district does not offer lab space or traditional classroom space. Yet, every effort should be made to get log into the program on a daily basis..

**Vacations/Camps** Students with vacation or camp plans conflicting with the summer program dates are still eligible to enroll in the High School Summer programs. Vacations and camp are not excused absences, and deadlines for completion will not be extended due to vacations and camps. Therefore students are encouraged to complete their coursework while on vacation/camps.

**Materials** Students are to provide their own devices and connectivity. **THE DISTRICT WILL NOT LOAN OUT DEVICES.** Students are encouraged to utilize their local library for connectivity or for additional reading materials.

**Registration Forms** Student registration form is located in this booklet. There will be a \$10.00 registration fee for non-New London Students.

## REGISTRATION INFORMATION

**REGISTRATION FOR NLHS STUDENTS: All registration for currently enrolled New London Local Schools students will take place through the High School Guidance Office.**

### **Non NLHS Student**

Students not currently enrolled in New London Local Schools (i.e. out of district, parochial and charter) must complete a paper application.

Registration for non-NLHS students will be held starting June 4 at New London High School Guidance Office: 1 Wildcat Drive, New London 44851 or the New London Board of Education Offices located at 2 Wildcat Drive, New London 44851.

There will be a \$10.00 registration fee for any Non-New London Students.

There are two ways to register:

2. Drop off a copy of the registration with payment to either the New London High School Guidance Office or the New London Board of Education Offices.

Payment must be made at time of registration and all registration must be received by June 10, 2019.

A valid email address must be provided on the registration form. This email address will be used to send login credentials and additional information regarding our online platform.

## TUITION & FEE INFORMATION

Tuition for all students is:

1 Credit Course and PE: \$150.00.

.5 Credit Course: \$100.00

**Tuition must be paid at the time of registration. Credit or debit cards are accepted. Cash or money order will be accepted at registration starting on June 3. Refunds will not be issued for incomplete work or for home districts not accepting credits. It is the responsibility of each student to verify their home district will accept credits earned during NLLS Summer School.**

**There will be a \$10.00 registration fee applied to all Non-New London Students.**

**Course Information:**

All Core Academic Classes are offered only as Credit Recovery. Health and P.E. are offered as both Credit Recovery and Credit Advancement.

Classes are held in an online setting monitored by a certified teacher. Credit will not be granted if less than 60% of the coursework is not completed.

**Course Load:** Students may register for a maximum of 2 courses, regardless of credits.

## **FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS ABOUT THE HIGH SCHOOL SUMMER LEARNING PROGRAMS**

### **1. Can anyone attend the high school summer learning program?**

Priority is given to currently enrolled New London Local Schools' students. Students who live in the New London Local School District attendance area, but attend a parochial or charter school can attend if space is available. Students who live outside of the district may enroll if space is available. Non-NL students will be charged a \$10.00 registration fee.

### **2. Is there a charge to attend the high school summer learning program?**

Yes. All registered students pay \$150.00 per full credit course and P.E. Half credit courses are \$100.00.

### **3. Where do I turn in my registration form and payment for the summer program?**

Registration for non-NL students begin June 3, 2019 either at the New London High School Guidance Office or the New London Board of Education Offices. Payment must be provided at time of registration. There will be a \$10.00 registration fee applied to all Non-NLHS students.

### **4. My child attends a parochial and/or charter school. Can my child attend the High School summer learning programs**

Non-NLLS students will be accepted. All high school students will be accepted if space allows. Please refer to the Registration Information on the previous page.

### **5. Can middle school students attend High School Summer school?**

No. At this time, only high school students are accepted into this program.
